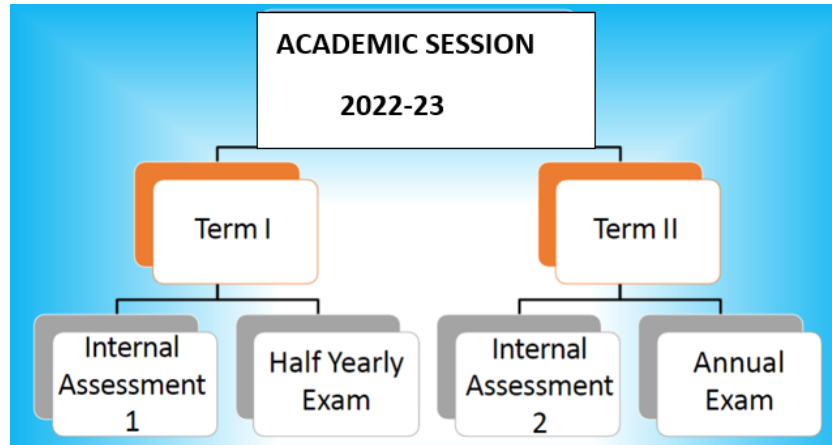




REMODELLED STRUCTURE OF ASSESSMENT FOR CLASS VI TO CLASS VIII

According to the revised assessment-structure and examination pattern, the academic session is divided into two terms: Term- 1 and Term-II



Thus, we have four exams in a year:

- Internal Assessment-1, and Half yearly Exam in Term 1 and
- Internal Assessment-2, and Annual Exam in Term II

Co-Scholastic Activities (Classes VI-VIII):

For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities in the following areas be carried out in CBSE affiliated schools by the teachers and will be graded term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair).

The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output, and teamwork be the generic criteria for grading in the following co-scholastic activities:

- (a) **Work Education** - Work Education refers to skill-based activities resulting in goods or services useful to the community
- (b) **Art Education** (Visual & Performing Art)
- (c) **Health and Physical Education** (Sports/Martial Arts/Yoga/NCC etc.)

Discipline (Classes VI-VIII):

The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation, and others.

Grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair)
